Introduction

Thank you for participating in the Power of the St. Croix Utility Box Mural Project. This project seeks qualified artists and is requesting proposals from individuals/teams from the surrounding community to create two-dimensional murals on selected transformer cabinets located in Marine on St. Croix and Stillwater. This is part of the **Power of the St. Croix Utility Box Mural Project,** which celebrates the St. Croix River and our local artistic talent, while mitigating the negative effects of graffiti and unwanted postings on utility boxes. It will also create lasting pieces of art that will improve the appearance of downtown for residents and visitors alike.

We hope to recognize and celebrate the local artists of our community, and develop a positive artistic vibe to the City of Stillwater and Marine on St. Croix. All submissions must revolve around the theme of the river. It is up to the artist to interpret that creatively.

Mission

The idea to transform something that is ugly-the common, bland green or grey utility boxes, into something beautiful is not new. Cities across the nation, from Minneapolis to Fort Collins, have completed similar projects to beautify andenliven their downtowns.





Theme

The theme of this project revolves around the River, as it is the River that connects all of our towns and villages. Submissions will be themed around the River. It could be the natural beauty of the river or the history of the river, it can be realist or abstract, it can be photography or a painting. There are endless possibilities with this project!

Artists Rules and Instructions

Please read the rules and instructions and make sure you are very familiar with them before starting work on your box.

Artists are responsible for implementing their approved proposal on their selected box.

Specifications

- 1. Artists should be from the approximate area.
- 2. Artists ne ed to submit renderings based on dimensions of the enclosed template and should include all sides. Note, actual boxes may be a different size or shape. Please draw your own template to match shape of your box as closely as possible. Artist signature must not exceed 3"x5" in actual size.
- 3. Artwork in draft must closely resemble the art that will be installed on the box.
- 4. All submitted proposals will become city property. There is no guarantee of how long the artwork may remain on box due to maintenance or replacement of box.
- Applicants should become familiar and know the measurements of their proposed box and the location around it in order to contextualize their proposal.
- 6. Judging will remain anonymous.
- 7. Selected artists will be notified by email.
- 8. Materials funds will be distributed directly to selected artists following the submission of a cost estimate by vinyl contractor. Each selected artist will have up to \$600 for materials and the installation of their piece. An additional stipend of \$300 will be paid directly to selected artists following the completion and submittal of photo documentation of mural.

Eligible Proposals

The artistic theme of these selected utility boxes will be the River. The boxes should become high quality artwork that will enliven the community. Proposals should be positive, original, and reflect that theme.

Proposals will be ineligible if they involve:

- A breach of intellectual property rights (all artwork must be original)
- Trademarks, brands, business names, logos, or copyrighted images.
- Anything harmfulto a third party

The City of Marine on St. Croix has approved the installation of murals through vinyl wrap only. Wrap will need to be installed by a professional vendor.

Vinyl Wrap

Artists need to make sure they measure all sides of box, and note any labels, handles, indents, or attachments. Digital renderings of your work must be full size 100 dpi or half size 200 dpi.



Please refer to the map below to select your box.




Box 1- Corner of Broadway and 6th Street






Box 2- Bike Trail, along Highway 95, just north of Chestnut Street
